## YEAR IN REVIEW

During our 2020 program year, a true highlight for ISP was the launch of the Ambassadors of Hope program for a pilot cohort of alumni leaders. Ambassadors are invited to use their gifts, talents and abilities to advance the mission of ISP while strengthening their recovery, deepening their spiritual lives, and walking with others on the journey. This special program empowers participants as leaders in our community.

The last third of our program year (March – June) looked very different once the COVID-19 pandemic arrived. While we could not rely on our usual in-person model of providing for the spiritual needs of our participants, we knew that the core of our mission was as critical as ever. During that often frightening and lonely time, invitations from isolation to connection and from pain to healing were desperately needed. ISP quickly pivoted to offering online and virtual support and reflection to our participants, and began planning more opportunities to engage our community in new and innovative ways.

The support of our partners and donors buoyed us during those early days of COVID, and helped us navigate those uncharted waters. We are grateful!

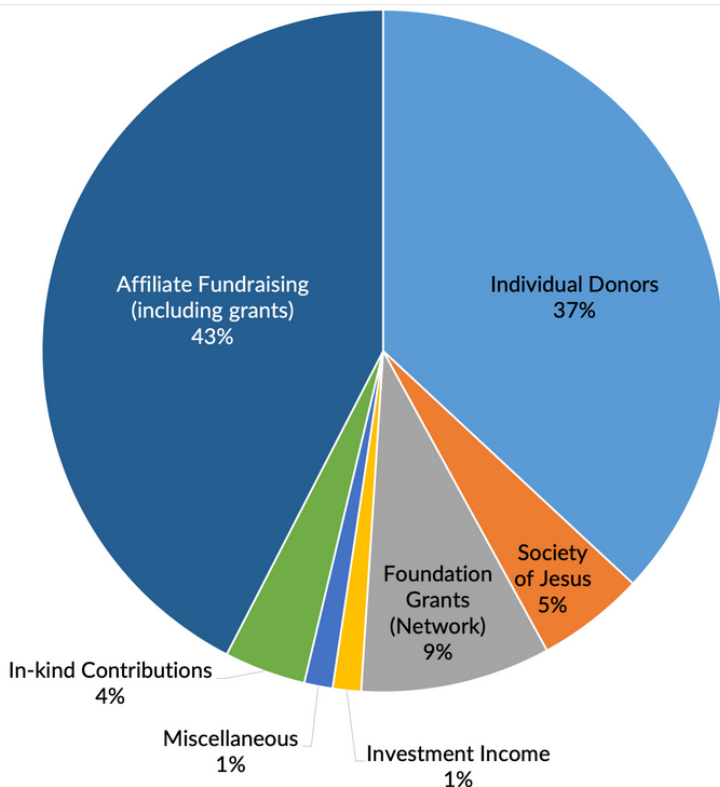

## ISP SUPPORT & REVENUE

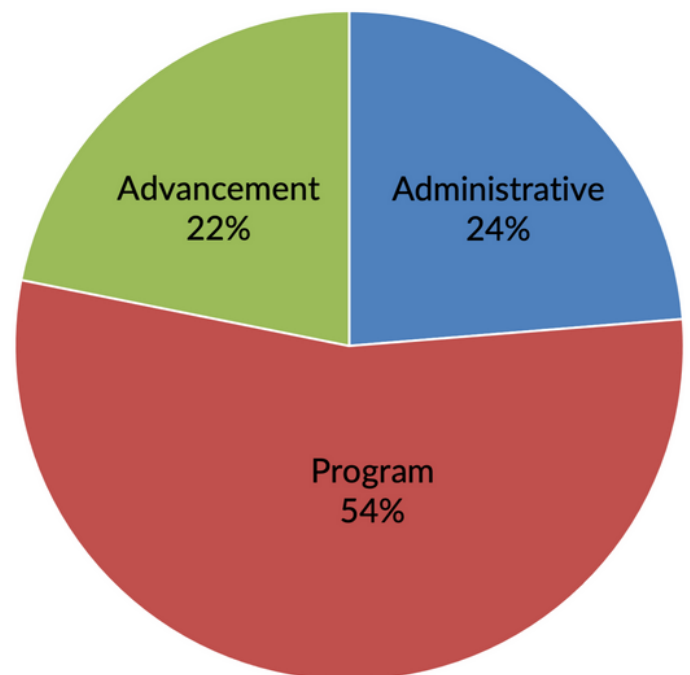
Fiscal Year Ending 6/30/2020
